

Opening Celebration

Kwinana Freeway Extension and Forrest Highway

20 September 2009

To commemorate the historic opening of the new road, an official ceremony will be held at the Pinjarra Road interchange between 10am and 12pm, prior to the opening to traffic later in the day.

The event will include family activities, such as face painting, petting zoo and rides. On the day you can also participate in a 32 kilometre bicycle ride.

Free shuttles will be provided to the event from the Mandurah Train Station, Pinjarra Junction shopping complex and the Baldivis Stockland complex for those travelling from Perth.
